POLICY #3

STUDENT ENROLLMENT

Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School welcomes all appropriately aged children from the Ka'ōhāo geographic school district and encourages all Ka'ōhāo families to consider enrolling their children in Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School, “A Path to Excellence in Learning and Life.” In addition, based on openings at each class level, Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School welcomes applicants for geographic exceptions. All families are viewed and valued as long-term participants in the Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School learning community.

Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School shall achieve stable and optimum enrollment levels to ensure that:

1. The quality of the classroom experience is enhanced by striving to maintain an optimum student-teacher ratio, based on current data and research, and by maintaining stability in grade-level enrollment from year to year;
2. Class sizes and the number of classes are adequately supported by classroom space and other physical facilities, learning facilities, and financial resources.

The Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School administration shall implement, review, and amend as required the enrollment procedures set forth in the Ka'ōhāo Public Charter School Administrative Enrollment Procedures. These procedures shall be made available upon request in hard copy to all applicants for enrollment, teachers, staff, Board members, and other interested parties of the school community.
