

V. CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

POLICY #1

DEVELOPMENT, ASSESSMENT, AND MODIFICATION OF CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

- (1) The governing board of Lanikai School accepts the responsibility of maintaining a curriculum that
 - a. reflects the goals and objectives of the school community as expressed in the school's purpose statements,
 - b. is reflective of State-adopted curriculum standards, and
 - c. meets the requirements of the law.
- (2) The Director or his/her designee shall have the general oversight and coordinating authority over the design and development of the curriculum, including
 - a. maintaining a process for curriculum review and development,
 - b. evaluating the effectiveness of curriculum and instruction in meeting the school's educational program needs, and
 - c. providing the governing board with reports on the significant results achieved in core academic courses as they become available so that the Board may monitor the extent to which the school has accomplished or made significant progress toward achieving its educational goals.
- (3) Based on evaluations and reports, the governing board may charge the Director or his/her designee to
 - a. take appropriate actions to maintain the effectiveness of programs, and/or
 - b. modify and improve curriculum and instructional strategies to improve the quality of education delivered by the school.
