

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE DR. ED NOH
CHESS CLUB FUND

On behalf of the teachers, staff and Governing Board of Ka'ohao Public Charter School, in recognition of Director Ed Noh's being awarded the degree of Doctorate in Education in Professional Educational Practice by the College of Education at the University of Hawaii at Manoa, the Governing Board hereby establishes the Dr. Ed Noh Chess Club Fund.

The purpose of the Fund shall be to enhance the quality of learning and achievement among the student members of the Ka'ohao School Chess Club. The Fund shall be solely for the benefit of the Club and may be expended at the discretion of the Director. The Fund shall be supported entirely by donations.

Dr. Noh initiated the Chess Club during the 2012-13 school year, his second as School Director. Dr. Noh was a chess novice himself at the time and has learned the game along with his students. The Club began with "a handful of kids" and now includes forty-six students from kindergarten through grade six. Dr. Noh describes his Thursday afternoons with the chess students as the highlight of his week.

The Governing Board congratulates Dr. Noh and our students for their achievement and looks forward to a Ka'ohao School chess champion.
